Qualifications: Ph.D. in Aviation or related discipline with expertise in Operations Management, Aviation Management, aircraft structures, and/or propulsion/engines. Applicants should have awareness of and sensitivity to the educational goals of a multicultural population as might have been gained in cross-cultural study, training, teaching and other comparable experience.

Responsibilities: The person in this position is expected to teach undergraduate courses in Aviation, maintain a program of scholarly activity, and assume leadership in curriculum development and department governance. In order to be eligible for appointment at the advanced rank, the successful candidate must have broad teaching experience and present demonstrated scholarly/professional achievement. Candidate must address the needs of a student population of great diversity – in age, cultural background, ethnicity, primary language and academic preparation – through course materials, teaching strategies and advisement.
